

CLUB ACTIVITIES

FAMA CLUB

Kaun Banega FAMA Champion

FAMA club organized KBFC (Kaun Banega FAMA Champion) on December 07, 2017 at Seminar hall of PIMG Campus. The main motive of the event was to check the awareness level of students in Finance, Commerce and Economics. The event was organized in two phases: 1. Screening 2. Main Event. Screening



Round was held at December 06, 2017, in which 45 Objectives types questions were asked.

There were 143 participants in total from various courses in the screening round. Out of 143 participants, 36 participants were selected for the final round. Final Round on the main event day was divided into two rounds i.e. Round 1 (Faster finger first) and Round 2 (KBFC). Questions were asked related to accounting, economics, commerce and general knowledge. Winning prize for the contestant were decided according to the level of questions they reach.

Level one prize i.e.after reaching till Question 5 was of rupees 1000, Level second prize (Ouestion 8) was of rupees 2000 and Level third prize money (question 15) was of 5000rs. The winner of the event was Mr. Harshit Rastogi, MBA III (A) who was able to reach upto question5 and win cash prize of Rs. 1000. The event was coordinated by Prof. Pooja Jain and Dr. Nandan Velankar.

One Day Session on Option Trading Strategies

On the 23th Dec. 2017, the department of management studies under the banner of FAMA Club organized a one-day session on "Option Trading Strategies". 102 students attended the Session. The session was Co-ordinated by Dr. Amitabha Maheshwari and Prof. Abhay Singh Chauhan, Co-Coordinated the session. The resource person of the

session was Mr. Sudipto Ghosh (Team Leader, Bank of America, Gurugram). The main objective behind the session was to enhance the knowledge about Derivatives and Option trading strategies among the students so as that have more clarity on the working of financial markets. Apart from this students also got the practical knowledge of various strategies of option trading.





The session was divided into two parts: Prelunch and Post lunch session. During the prelunch session, after the introduction, the resource person started his session. First half of the session was theory based in which the resource person covered a wide area of stock market in line with suitable examples. He started the session with the brief introduction of stock markets, derivatives and its types in India. Along with it he also gave the practical examples for

Futures, call option, Put option, how to buy and sale the securities, etc. This session lasted till 1 o'clock which was followed by the post-lunch second session in which he explained all the technicalities of option trading strategies in details. Participating students showed a lot of interest in this session which was thus followed by various relevant questions.

BUNCH OF MARKETING BELIEVERS CLUB

Brand Mulyankan - (Best and Worst of Brand)

Brand Mulyankan (Best and Worst of Brand) was held on December 13, 2017. Total 43 teams registered for the event, each team consisting of two participants. The event was held in two rounds. In first round, each team had to present a presentation on a given



brand names, and they were supposed to register themselves with a brand name. they were asked to prepare a presentation on a particular brand and for that 5 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes was given for queries by judges.

The Round one presentation included Introduction (history of brand, market share, present scenario, competitors), Best of brand, Worst of brand and Conclusion.

The team of judges evaluated these presentations, and total 10 teams were taken to the next round. In round two, one product was given to the selected teams and 5 minutes were given to them for preparation and 2 minutes were for enactment for the advertising that product and then judges evaluated the participants on four basis i.e., content, appeal,



creativity and persuasion. The winning team was Vishal Agarwal and Arti Prasad. The First Runner Up were Aditi Dubey and Ashi Soni and Second Runner Up were Mansi Agarwal and Koshiki Shrivastava.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CELL

Women Entrepreneurship Development Program

PIMG conducted one month Women Entrepreneurship Development Programme in association with MPCON Gwalior. It lasted from 17 - Sep - 2017 to 25 - Oct - 2017 and had 28 students enrolled for the same.

Inauguration – Program was started with Lamp lighting ceremony in the auspicious presence of Dr S. S. Bhakar, Director, PIMG and Er. Aashish Bhargava, Zonal director,

MPCon. After inaugural programme, session was conducted by Dr Navita Nathani on Programme objectives, expectations from trainees, programme strategy etc.

During the programme sessions were conducted on various themes such as Entrepreneurship and its Characteristics; Personality development topics like achievement motivation training, tools for effective Communication and public speaking were discussed with the participants. Sessions on Role of DTIC, State & Central Govt. Schemes operated by DTIC and other supporting agencies were also conducted. Some basic topics like definition of Business/Service/Industry and its basis of selection, screening of ideas and business opportunities identification were also held. Panel discussion was also planned to understand the society readiness, problems and challenges for women entrepreneurs in Indian Society. Lastly a Factory Visit was planned in which students visited Nova Factory situated in Malanpur area. Apart from this, students also learned to make project plans which were evaluated after completion of training and best two plans were awarded. At the end of the WEDP, Valedictory Ceremony was held where the certificates were distributed to the participants by Dr. S S Bhakar and Mr. Ashish Bharqav.

Technical Entrepreneurship Development Program

PIMG organized a one and a half month long Technical Entrepreneurship Development Program in association with MPCON, Gwalior from November 6, 2017 to December 18, 2017. It had a strength of 25 students. The program was on low cost building material and was specially targeted for students from science and technology background.

For becoming participants, the applicants of the program had to undergo rigorous interview process. The program was designed in such a way so that the students may learn the use of technology in identifying business opportunities in manufacturing and service sectors.

The lectures on conduct of market survey, essential technical skills for digital marketers and opportunities in service marketing for technology based entrepreneurship were the most appreciated lectures. The biggest challenge in front of entrepreneur is to manage time and to keep in mind the same some of the lectures were conducted on time management and stress management as well. A visit to Taragram, Orchha was also planned in the end of the programme where students visited small and cottage units of handicrafts, fly ash bricks and stationary products.

1. - 3. Local Promotion Committee: Responsibility of Promoting Spandan at Local level was assigned to this committee as a result of this committee's efforts we have received participation of 30 institutes from the city total number of participants from these institutions was 350. This number is highest in the history of PIMG.
- 4. Internal Arrangement Committee: Committee was assigned with the major responsibility of making internal arrangement during the whole three days event. Arrangements made by the committee were superb not a single miss was there from committee's side note by any of the event or committee Coordinator.
- 5. Hospitality Committee: This year we have added this committee to facilitate judges of different event such as receive them from judges committee, send them or guide them towards the different venue of events as this committee did a good job and Institute has decided that from next year onwards this committee will be there to take care of judges.
