Assistive technology and facilities for Divyangjan

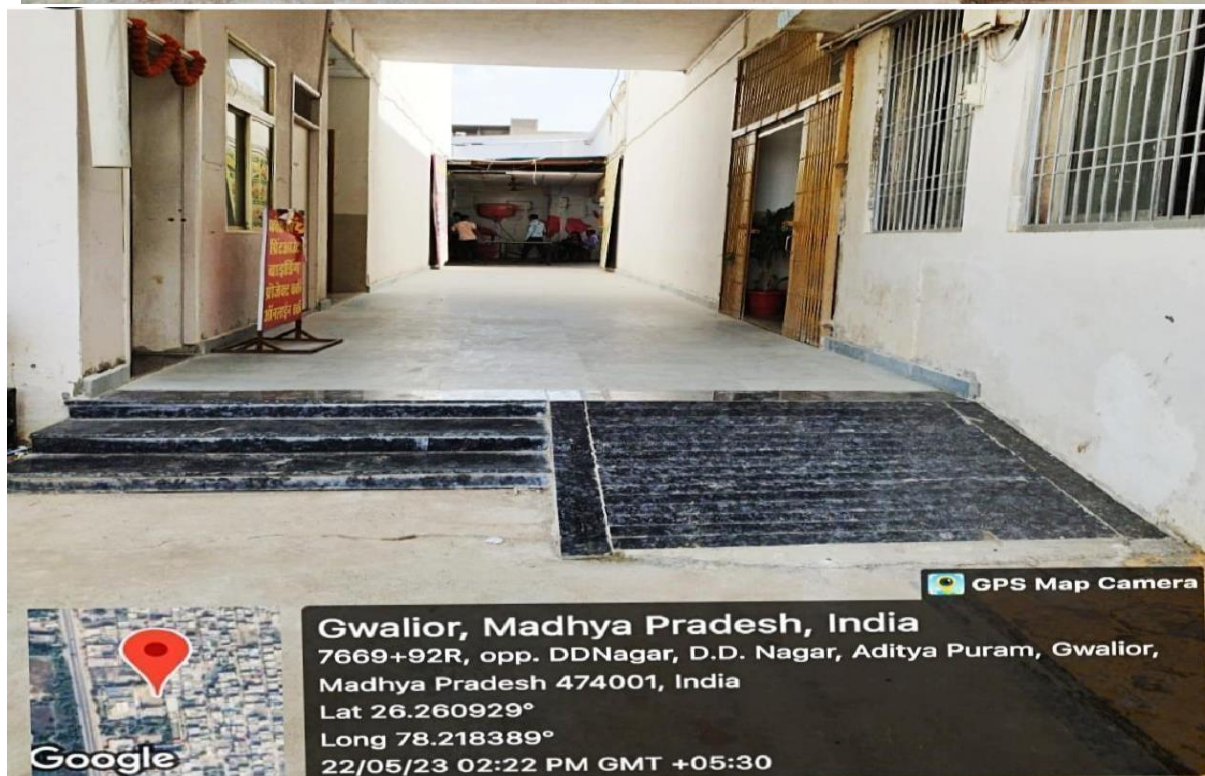
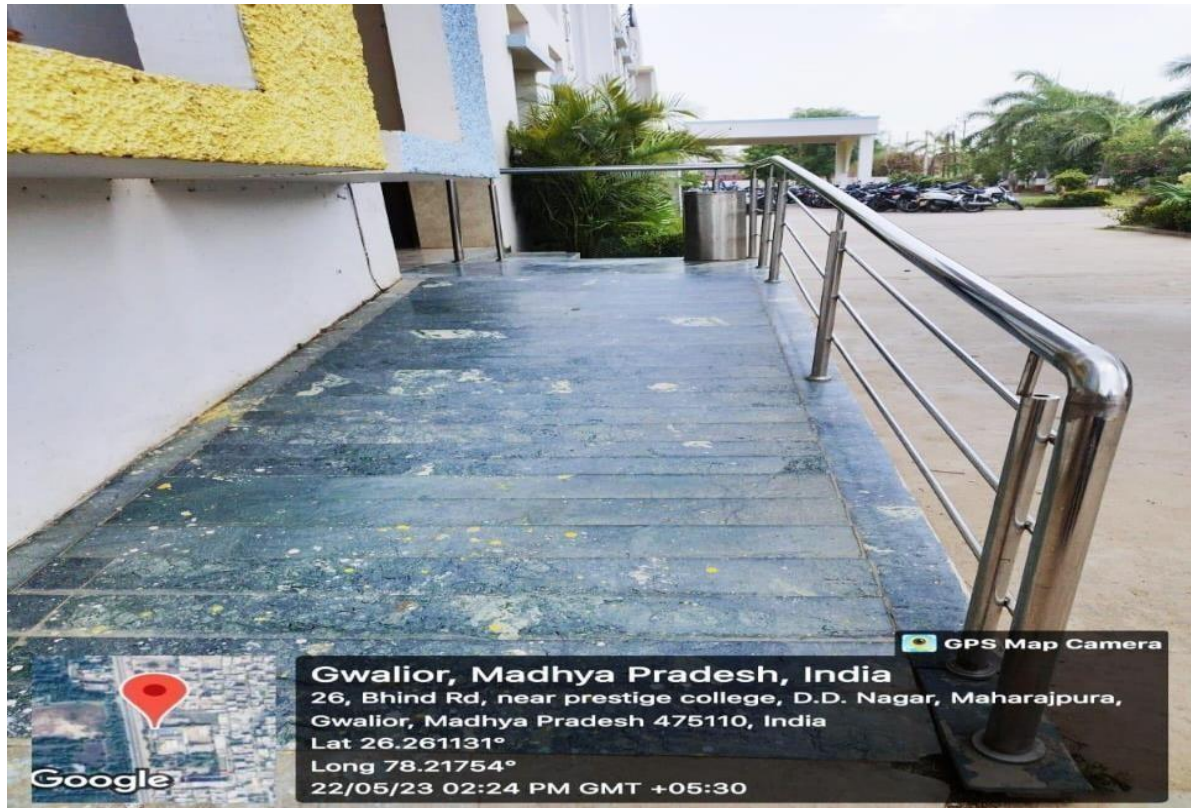
Screen reading software is available on designated computers in Computer Labs as well as in Library to facilitate Differently-abled (Divyangjan) individuals.
